

FREE INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE

If you are an older adult, disabled resident, or member of a low-income family living in Morris, Sussex, or Warren County then you may be eligible for FREE tax assistance with both your Federal and State Income Tax Returns and Homestead Rebate.

The VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) Program is staffed with IRS Trained and Certified volunteers who donate their time to assist members of the community with tax preparation services.

All services are 100% free of charge and are available on a first come-first served basis. Sites are only able to assist residents with simple tax filings and NJ Homestead Rebate filings.

Appointments are necessary and can be scheduled starting the second week in January.

Sites will open the first week of February and will conclude operations on April 15th. Residents are asked to bring all documentation to their tax appointment. This includes prior year's tax return, all income statements (Social Security, Pension, W-2's, and 1099's, etc.), and any applicable divorce or custody agreements. Additionally, all clients MUST show a photo id and provide a Social Security Card for yourself and every individual listed on your return or they will be turned away.
